MASKING PROTOCOL

The following protocols relative to masking must be followed at every District school site:

- 1) Regardless of one's vaccination status, masking is required indoors for all individuals in all indoor settings (including in classrooms, workrooms, offices, gymnasiums, and all common areas) at all times. Put simply, if you are indoors on a school campus, you must mask!
- 2) <u>Regardless of one's vaccination status</u>, masking is NOT required in any *outdoor setting* (including in parking lots, on playgrounds, in exterior quads, etc.) on any school campus. Individuals *may* continue to mask while outdoors if they so choose, but that is strictly a personal choice.

Please be sure your child carries extra masks in their backpack.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Attendance is extremely important for the success of your child's education. We are requesting that you send an email to ckattend@srvusd.net to inform the office if your child is ill, will be late, or for some other reason, your child is not coming to school whether the absence is for part of the day or the entire day. This procedure helps to assure the safety of your child. It is important that you include the child's name (first and last) and the reason why your child is out as well as identifying yourself. Please let us know if your child will be absent no later than 30 minutes after school begins. If we do not hear from you, your child will be marked as truant.

SCHOOL LUNCH AVAILABLE AT NO COST

Due to changes to the Federal and State Child Nutrition Programs, school lunch will be available to **all** SRVUSD students at no cost for the 2021-22 school year.

BE A MENTOR – PROCESS FOR SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

Short Term Independent Study: The Board approved revisions to BP/AR 6158 Independent Study and the final document will be available soon. Until then, we wanted to point out several changes relating to the short term contracts. The timeframe went from 20 to 14 days. Parent requests must be submitted 3 to 5 days prior for contracts up to 10 days. Contracts for 11 to 14 days require a 5 to 10 day notice.
