### **MASKING**

Masking guidance can be found on the district [Back to School Website](#)

- Masks are mandatory for everyone regardless of vaccination status when indoors.

- Masks should completely cover the nose and mouth and nose wires are encouraged to prevent air from leaking out of the top of the mask.
- Mask types that ARE ALLOWED: Multi-layered cloth masks, surgical masks, N95 masks, and neck gaiters with two layers, or are folded to make two layers
- Mask types that ARE NOT ALLOWED: Single layer neck gaiters, bandanas, and masks with valves

We have masks available in the front office and classrooms for students that need them.

## TRAFFIC

Always remember, safety is our top priority, not speed!

- The front drive thru is for VEHICLE pick up only- all parents on foot must wait in the designated "parent waiting zone" area in the front of the school
- All students waiting for their vehicle must be seated under their grade level number. Siblings may sit together.
- Parents in the drive thru should stay in their vehicles. Teachers, staff, and Safety Patrol will assist students as needed
- The stairs by the office should be kept clear at all times (unless it is raining).
- Bus riders should be seated on the grass area (below the Kindergarten buildings) while waiting for the bus.

## OTHER

- Students who are under 8 years of age must be secured in a car seat or booster seat in the back seat.
- Anyone under the age of 18 and operating a bicycle must legally wear a helmet.

## STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Attendance is extremely important for the success of your child's education. We are requesting that you send an email to [ckattend@srvusd.net](mailto:ckattend@srvusd.net) to inform the office if your child is ill, will be late, or for some other reason, your child is not coming to school whether the absence is for part of the day or the entire day. This procedure helps to assure the safety of your child. It is important that you include the child's name (**first and last**) and **the reason why your child is out** as well as **identifying** yourself. Please let us know if your child will be absent **no later than 30 minutes** after school begins. If we do not hear from you, your child will be marked as **truant**.

## **INDEPENDENT STUDY**

Short Term Independent Study: The Board approved revisions to BP/AR 6158 Independent Study and the final document will be available soon. Until then, we wanted to point out several changes relating to the short term contracts. The timeframe went from 20 to 14 days. Parent requests must be submitted 3 to 5 days prior for contracts up to 10 days. Contracts for 11 to 14 days require a 5 to 10 day notice.
